Character	Character is fully embodied throughout: consistent voice, physicality, and motivation, with no breaks.	Character is strong and mostly consistent. Only minor, brief lapses. Collaboration	Consistently "yes, and"s, embracing scene partners' contributions and building on them to advance the scene .
